Ring and Chain Method

Beginner

Materials:

Lizbeth® Thread size 10 #189-Pink Ice
Lizbeth® Thread size 10 #644- Boysenberry
Tatting Needle or Two Tatting shuttle

Definitions of Abbreviations

R = Ring sp = small picot
(- or p) = picot Ch = Chain
rw = reverse work DNR + Do Not Reverse
Cl = Close (+) = join



NOTE: Advanced tatters can do split ring out of center. After making Center R then do for the first R of Outer Round - R 6/SR 6 Cl Rw. Continue to the first Ch as written.

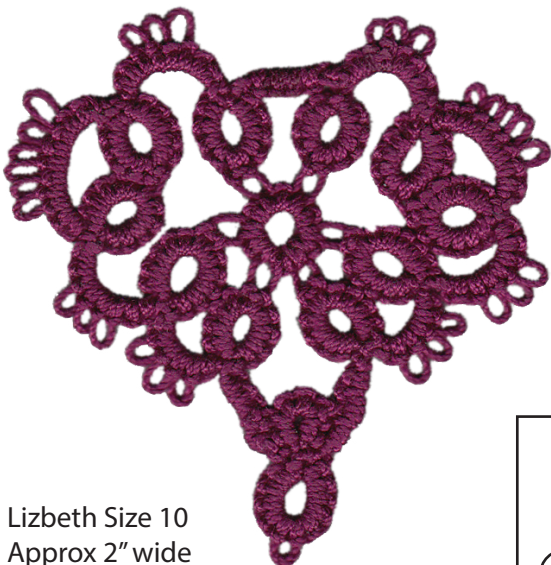
CENTER:

R: 1-2-2-2-2-1 Cl
Tie/Hide/Cut

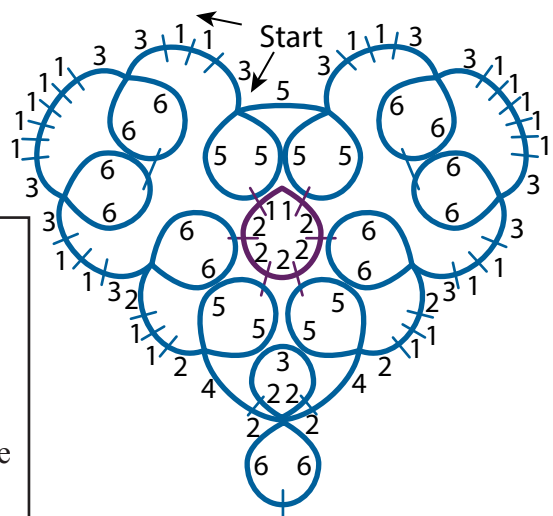
Outer Round:

R: 5+(to any p of CENTER) 5 Cl rw
*Ch: 3-1-1-3 rw
R: 6 sp 6 Cl rw
Ch: 3-1-1-1-1-3 rw
R: 6+(to sp of prev. R) 6 Cl rw
Ch: 3-1-1-3 rw*

R: 6+(to next p of CENTER) 6 Cl rw
Ch: 2-1-1-2 rw
R: 5+(to next p of CENTER) 5 Cl DNR
Ch: 4 sp 2 rw
R: 6-6 Cl rw
R: 2+(to sp of prev. Ch) 3 sp 2 Cl DNR
Ch: 2+(to sp of prev. R) 4 DNR
R: 5+(to next p of CENTER) 5 Cl rw
Ch: 2-1-1-2 rw
R: 6+(to next p of CENTER) 6 Cl rw
Repeat from * to * one time.
R: 5+(to last p of CENTER) 5 Cl DNR
Ch: 5
Tie/Hide/Cut to base of first R made. If desired run a safety pin in the middle of the last chain made.
